



- In April 2011 the Government of Russian Federation granted ALROSA licenses for developing diamond deposits «Verkhne-Munskoe» and «Maiskoe». Both new deposits has been discovered earlier by ALROSA during geological investigations in Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), eastern region of Russia.
- «Verkhne-Munskoe» diamond deposit consists of three kimberlite pipes. Total reserves of the diamond deposit are more than 38 mln ct, average grade – 0.6 ct/t, the average price as of today – more than 210 USD/ct.
- «Maiskoe» diamond deposit consists of one kimberlite pipe. Reserves of the diamond deposit are about 12 mln ct, average grade – 3.7 ct/t, the average price as of today – about 90 USD/ct.
- Both diamond deposits are located within ALROSA's existing production facilities in western part of Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), developing of the deposits will not require significant CAPEX and will encourage further stability of ALROSA's production.
